Who is LIT for?

This program is designed for teens who are eager for Christ-centered discipleship and have a desire to learn more about Christian Camp Ministry. Applicants must at least be turning 15 AND going into grade 10 in 2019.

What is LIT all about?

Through the LIT Program you will discover how to become a great camp staff member through a variety of training sessions. You will be challenged through insightful Bible studies, Scripture memorization, team building, and service opportunities. In addition to two weeks of intensive discipleship, you will also have lots of fun throughout the program – whether that’s finally being a leader in Mission Impossible, having water fights with the campers, participating in beach day, or one of many other awesome things!

Following the two weeks of training, you may have an opportunity to serve as a volunteer in one of several positions. This would likely include junior cabin leading, work teams, kitchen help, or wrangling for at least one of the following three weeks. This will give you a chance to put everything you have learned into practice, while working alongside our more experienced staff.

When does LIT run?

If you would like to participate in this program, you must be willing to dedicate at least four weeks of your summer to camp in addition to a mandatory evening training on May 24. The four weeks during the summer include July 1-5 (Staff Training), July 14-19 (LIT Week 1), July 21-26 (LIT Week 2), and at least one of the following three weeks: July 28-August 2, August 5-8, and/or August 11-16. The two LIT weeks are specifically dedicated to studying God’s Word and learning about Camp Ministry; your following week(s) will give you a chance to serve at camp and apply what you have learned. The underlying goal, however, is to help prepare you to step into ministry wherever God leads you in the future.

How much does LIT cost?

The LIT Program costs a total of \$295, which is due upon acceptance of your application. This covers everything including accommodations, food, and study materials for your LIT weeks.

How do I join LIT?

If you are interested in applying, pick up a copy of the application form at FBC or go to www.pleasantviewcamp.org and download the LIT application form along with the required reference forms. Remember, space in the program is limited, so complete your application and return it to us as soon as possible. Applications are due by April 1, 2019.
